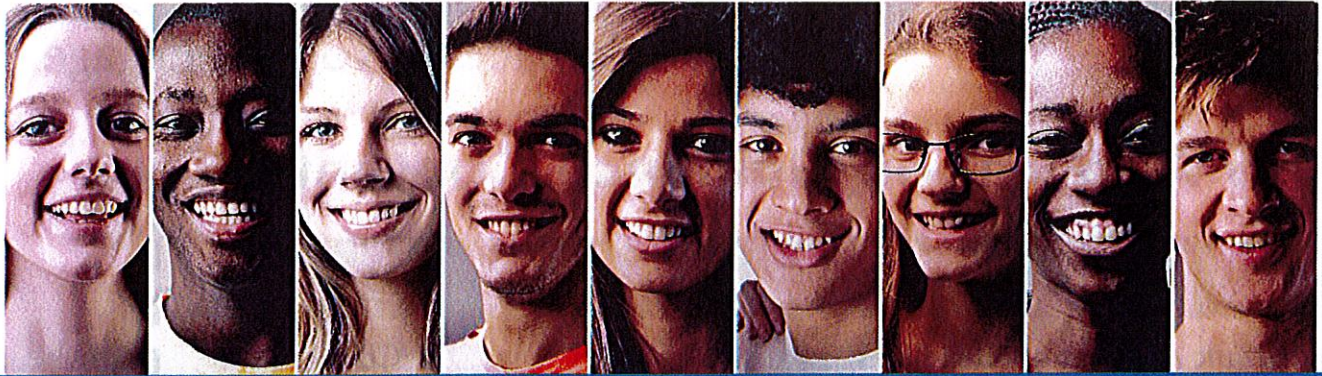

7. Sexual Assault and Harassment

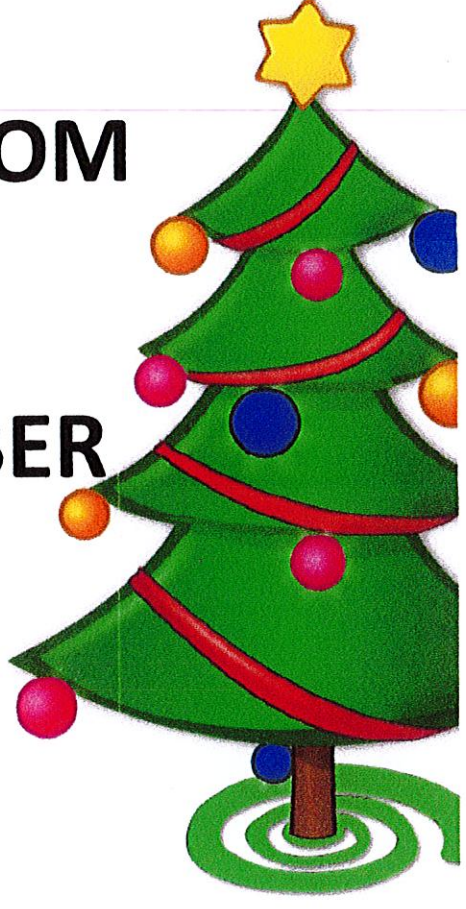
