



HEAP is opening Tuesday, November 1st 2022.

You may apply in person, online or applications can be sent through the mail, email or fax, or through Office for the Aging 845-807-0241.

Households active on SNAP or Temporary Assistance may be able to receive a HEAP benefit directly through their case.

The following are the base regular benefit amounts for the 2022-2023 HEAP season:

Electric Natural Gas	\$400.00
Oil Kerosene Propane	\$900.00
Wood Wood Pellets Coal	\$635.00

HEAP Regular Benefit is a one-time only benefit meant to supplement your fuel expense. It is not a monthly benefit.

The HEAP Emergency Benefit begins January 3rd 2023. This benefit is for households that may be in an emergency situation regarding their main source of heat. This benefit can be applied for over the phone. Please call 845-807-0142 for emergency benefit only.
