OUR MISSION: To honor and recognize Town of Lumberland men and women who have served in the United States Armed Forces, or are currently serving. Service member must be from the Town of Lumberland or lived in the Town of Lumberland. He or she must have been honorably discharged.

The banners will be in the hamlet of Glen Spey on Proctor Road (County Road 32) starting at Forestburgh Road (County Road 42) going west toward the Town of Highland. Then they will be on County Road 31 starting at Forestburgh Road (County Road 41) going east toward the hamlet of Mongaup.

Banners are made of double sided, vinyl material and are 30 by 60 inches. Each banner will include service person's name, branch of service, era or war served in and a photograph. Photograph should be 5x7 or 8x10 copy of veteran in military uniform or veteran service organization attire (best quality available as they are blown up on banner). If not possible original may be used and will be returned.

Cost: Banners and mounting brackets cost \$210.00.
