RESOLUTION – GOOSETOWN RADIOS CONTRACT APPROVAL

WHEREAS: the Town of Lumberland had previously entered into contract with Goosetown Communications to provide radios and service for the Highway Department, the Constabulary and Municipal Offices, and

WHEREAS: the existing contract has expired and the Town is seeking to renew a contract for a term of 24 months at a cost of \$1,400.00 per month for the radios and service, commencing on the first day of the month following the date of installation of the equipment with a one 24 month automatic renewal, upon the approval of the current Town Board, and

WHEREAS: payments of \$8,400.00 will be made semi-annually, in advance, upon billing by the Lessor for each six month period for the term of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland approve the contract with Goosetown Communications to provide radios and service, with the Lessor to install the equipment within 120 days after the date of the approval by the Town Board.
