

Resolution #85, 2012

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING WITH RESPECT TO PROPOSED LOCAL LAW #2 OF 2012 WHICH WOULD REPEAL LOCAL LAW #2 OF 1990 ENTITLED "ALARM".

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the collective attention of the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland that registration of private alarm systems with the Town Clerk appears to be unnecessary due to technological advances in the monitoring of alarm systems by alarm companies, and

WHEREAS repealing said Local Law 2 of 1990 appears to be a Type II action under SEQRA and no further review is required under SEQRA;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland wishes to set a time and place for a public hearing for consideration of a Local Law that repeals Local Law #2 of 1990 requiring the registration and permitting of private alarm systems.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a Public Hearing be held by the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland with respect to the aforesaid proposed Local Law at 7:15 p.m. on Monday, June 11, 2012, at Lumberland Town Hall, 1054 Proctor Rd., Glen Spey, New York 12737; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause public notice of said hearing to be given as provided by law.
