

**RESOLUTION #88, 2012**

**RESOLUTION – ASSESSOR’S OFFICE TEMPORARY  
INCREASED HOURS REQUEST & BUDGET MODIFICATION**

WHEREAS: the Town of Lumberland Assessor is requesting a temporary increase in hours for her Data Collector and Clerk due to the recent zoning changes going into effect that will result in the evaluating of properties affected by the changes, and

WHEREAS: the Assessor is requesting the Data Collector’s hours be increased from 12 hours to 18 hours and the Clerk’s hours be increased from 6 hours to 12 hours for a 3 month period, commencing in June, 2012, and

WHEREAS: the following Budget Modification is needed:
