

Resolution #92, 2012

RESOLUTION DECLARING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND ADOPTING LOCAL
LAW NO. 2 OF 2012

WHEREAS, a resolution was duly adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland for a public hearing to be held on June 11, 2012, at 7:15 p.m. at Lumberland Town Hall, 1054 Proctor Rd., Glen Spey, New York 12737, to hear all interested parties on a proposed Local Law entitled "Repeal Alarm Law"; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the Sullivan County Democrat, the official newspaper of said Town, on May 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly held on June 11, 2012, at 7:15 p.m. at Lumberland Town Hall, 1054 Proctor Rd., Glen Spey, New York 12737, and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, or any part thereof, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to part 617 of the implementing regulations pertaining to article 8 State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) it has been determined by the Town Board of said Town that adoption of said proposed Local Law would not have a significant effect upon the environment and could be processed by other applicable governmental agencies without further regard to SEQRA, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of said Town to adopt said Local Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland hereby adopts said Local Law No.2 of 2012, entitled "Repeal Alarm Law"; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and she hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and in the Local Law Book of the Town of Lumberland, and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State of New York.
