The Town of Lumberland is looking toward the future and asking its residents to help by filling out a survey. As part of updating the Town's Comprehensive Plan, the document that sets a vision for the Town's future and guides Town policy, Lumberland is conducting a survey to collect the opinions of Town residents and business owners. Surveys were mailed to a sampling of 538 of Lumberland's 967 households, but is also available to complete online at: https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/Lumberland_Survey. Surveys must be completed by **April 8, 2016**.

Lumberland's current Comprehensive Plan was completed in 2007, and the survey seeks to assess perspectives on issues the Town has faced over the past decade. The update is being funded by a grant from the Upper Delaware Council, and must be completed by the grant deadline of August 22, 2016. The survey was compiled with the assistance of the Sullivan County Division of Planning and Environmental Management and by the Town's Comprehensive Plan Update Committee; Sue Gregg, Chad Martell, Town Supervisor Jenny Mellan, Legislator Nadia Rajs, Christine Smetaniuk, and Sharon Sparling. Town Supervisor, Jenny Mellan encourages all residents to make their voices heard by participating in the survey.

**Sullivan County's Annual Litter Pluck Event Scheduled for Saturday, April 23
through Sunday, May 1, 2016**

Sullivan County Legislature has announced that Sullivan County's Annual Litter Pluck Event will take place from Saturday, April 23 through Sunday, May 1, 2016, and all school and community groups, as well as private citizens are urged to participate. The full legislative board voted to fund the bags and the associated waste disposal fees for this annual litter pluck event, through the Division of Public Works and Solid Waste, at its full board meeting on March 17, 2016.

Public Works Committee Chair Joseph Perrello encourages County residents to check with their local municipalities as there are several organized litter plucks events being planned throughout the County. "Litter is not only an issue in the Route 17 corridor towns; it needs to be addressed county wide and participation in a town or village organized litter pluck event is a great way to combat this ugly problem at a local level" stated Perrello. He continued "as Sullivan County looks forward to anticipated growth and increased tourism the roadsides need to better reflect the natural beauty of the County, not be covered in litter."

All residents and groups who wish to participate in Litter Pluck can pick up their Litter Pluck bags any time on or after Friday, April 15, 2016 at their Town or Village Hall or local Transfer Station. While no coupons are required, all Litter Pluck refuse must be placed in clear bags and participants will be asked register at the Transfer Station at the time of disposal. Roadside refuse will be accepted free-of-charge at all County Transfer Stations during the scheduled event dates.

**THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND REQUIRES ALL DOGS HARBORED IN
THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND BE LICENSED. A VALID RABIES
CERTIFICATE IS THE REQUIREMENT TO LICENSE YOUR PET. FOR
THOSE SENIOR CITIZENS (65+) YOU WILL ONLY HAVE TO PAY \$1
ANNUALLY FOR EACH SPAYED/NEUTERED DOG AND \$3 FOR EACH
UNSPAYED/UNNEUTERED DOG. ALL OTHER LICENSES ARE \$3.50
ANNUALLY FOR EACH SPAYED/NEUTERED DOG AND \$13.50 FOR
EACH UNSPAYED/UNNEUTERED DOG. IT IS FOR YOUR SAFETY
THAT YOU LICENSE YOUR DOG. IF YOUR DOG IS PICKED UP BY
OUR DOG CONTROL OFFICER AND TAKEN TO THE SHELTER THE
CHARGE IS \$10 FOR THE 1ST TIME, \$20 THE SECOND TIME AND \$30
FOR THE 3RD TIME WITHIN A 12 MONTH PERIOD. THERE IS ALSO A
\$3 A DAY CHARGE ADDED TO THAT IMPOUNDMENT FEE. THE
TOWN OF LUMBERLAND HAS A LEASH LAW.**




