Line up will begin between 11:30 -11:45 am and the parade will step off at 12:00 noon.


Deanna Rajsz will be there to help participants line up and distribute tickets for refreshments after the parade.


Light refreshments will be provided at the Senior Center to all parade participants.

# CONSTABULARY

We at your Constabulary hope that you are enjoying the start of the summer in our beautiful town of Lumberland. There are many activities that we may partake in as we enjoy the great outdoors. Safety though should be paramount in everyone's mind. The following is a few reminders and common courtesies that we should all follow which will help make this summer season enjoyable for everyone.

1. Fireworks possession is illegal in the State of New York. If you, your loved ones or friends should be injured by fireworks the repercussions are significant including the likelihood of lawsuits, fines and possible incarceration. PLEASE keep this in mind as you enjoy the 4th of July holiday.

2. Driving while intoxicated is something you don't want to get caught up in. If you do indulge be sure not to get behind the wheel. Have a designated driver on hand or call a cab. Besides being arrested and possibly spending a weekend in jail the average expense including court costs, lawyer fees and DMV fines can exceed \$10,000.00. Don't be that guy or gal!

3. Be courteous and respectful when operating watercraft on Mohican Lake. Minimize your wake and always wear your personal flotation device. Statistics have shown that those that wear lifejackets rarely perish.

4. When operating ATV's (quads) always wear a helmet and operate in a safe manner PLEASE respect your neighbor's property rights and STAY off the roads.

## **E-Z PASSS PROGRAM**

**PLEASE BE AWARE THAT THE TOWN CLERK'S OFFICE HAS GOTTEN APPROVAL TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE NYS THRUWAY AUTHORITY TO SELL E-Z PASS ON THE GO KITS. WE WILL PROBABLY NOT BE UP AND RUNNING FOR 4 – 6 WEEKS BUT WE LOOK FORWARD TO OFFERING THIS SERVICE TO OUR RESIDENTS. THE COST, ONCE WE HAVE THE PROGRAM UP AND RUNNING, WILL BE \$25 PER PASS. ONCE YOU PURCHASE THE PASS FROM THIS OFFICE IT WILL BE YOUR OBLIGATION TO REGISTER THE PASS VIA PHONE OR INTERNET. IT WILL ALSO BE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO PUT MORE MONEY ON THE PASS ONCE YOU HAVE DEPLETED THE ORIGINAL \$25. E-Z PASSES ARE NOW ACCEPTED FOR USE IN 15 STATES. THESE PASSES WILL ALSO MAKE GREAT GIFTS!**

**(Annual Licenses run from 10/1 of each year to 9/30 of the next year. This is a set annual fee no matter when you come in to get a license).**

**1 DAY RESIDENT LICENSE - \$ 5.00**

**7 DAY RESIDENT LICENSE - \$15.00**

**SENIOR RESIDENT LICENSE – (70+) - \$5.00**

### **NON-RESIDENT FISHING LICENSE**

**SEASON NON-RESIDENT LICENSE -- \$70.00**

## **DOG LICENSES**

**PLEASE BE AWARE THAT IT IS A LAW IN THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND TO HAVE YOUR DOG LICENSED IF THE DOG IS HARBORED IN THE TOWN. ALL LICENSES REQUIRE A VALID RABIES CERTIFICATE. THIS LAW IS FOR THE DOG OWNER'S PROTECTION, ESPECIALLY IF YOUR DOG GETS LOST OR WANDERS AWAY. THERE IS ALSO A LEASH LAW IN THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND.**

## Building Permits

It is important that when you obtain a building permit that you complete the project and get a Certificate of Occupancy or a Certificate of Compliance. Legally no building can be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. It's the responsibility of the permit holder to notify the Building Department through all stages of progress and call for inspections. Permits that have expired become part of the property record, and will hinder the sale or transfer of the property when a records violation search is done. Please call the building if you have any questions.

We have had many exciting things happening at the fire department! First off I am happy to announce that the siren will once again sound during fires and any other major disaster. The siren's electric service was terminated by O & R and deemed "not usable". After many, many phone calls, testing with a generator to see if this 60 plus year old siren could even work again and employing Voltron electric, the job has finally got a work order by the lovely O & R. Then of course we were told trees were in the way of the new wires! Fear not! Within hours, Bosco and the Town Guys, Jay and Rich, came and cleared the trees and branches so the electric service could be run. They were thoughtful in what they had to cut, and the fire department was asked for input. Thank you!

**BIG NEWS!** We have purchased a "new to us" ambulance to replace our aging 1995 Ford. We got a great deal on a used CHEVY Kodiak 4500. The new Chevy is a beautiful burgundy color and has all the bells and whistles we need, and most importantly, a reliable motor. Now changing things over from one ambulance to another is quite laborious. We have had three days of marathon work sessions, (almost 24 hours logged already) at the firehouse with many members stopping and lending a hand whenever they could. Eric has worked non stop on the radio installation. Ann and Terry have hours and hours into transferring supplies and Jacob, Charlie, Dakota, Jay, Bosco, Travis, Faith and Donny have been instrumental in helping with this incredible process. The state inspection for both ambulances to qualify for NYS Dept. of Health recertification is Monday, July 1st. We plan on passing with flying colors. This inspection was just a little more time intensive because we wanted to certify our new Chevy. Look for the new rig at the Fourth of July Parade! She is going to be the first due ambulance now!

Thank you also goes out to the Lumberland Fire Department Auxiliary. I asked Judi, the president, if they could sanitize the kitchen and clean out all the old stuff in there. By that afternoon, Cathy, Judi and Anita were on the job.






