

Resolution #125, 2016

RESOLUTION – COHEN LAW GROUP SERVICES APPROVAL

WHEREAS: the Town of Lumberland's franchise agreement with Time Warner Cable was due to expire, and

WHEREAS: upon reviewing the franchise agreement it was determined that an error was made by Time Warner Cable in the amount that they had been paying the Town for services, and

WHEREAS: the Cohen Law Group has submitted a letter of engagement for services to recoup the lost revenues owed to the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland approve the engagement letter and enlist the services of the Cohen Law Group to recoup the additional 2%, for the prior six (6) years, that was omitted from the revenues submitted to the Town by Time Warner Cable, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED: that the Town will pay Cohen Law Group an hourly rate of \$225 will be paid for all Attorneys, to be billed monthly, and which does not include expenses such as photocopying, postage, or if necessary, travel costs.
