**RESOLUTION – CONTINUE LANDFILL MONITORING
AGREEMENT APPROVAL – BARTON & LOGUIDICE**

WHEREAS: the New York Department of Conservation has deemed it necessary for the Town of Lumberland to monitor the old landfill, and

WHEREAS: the Engineering Firm of Barton & Loguidice performed the landfill monitoring services in 2015 and have verified they will continue to do the landfill monitoring in 2016 upon approval, and

WHEREAS: Barton & Loguidice Engineering Firm has submitted the following quotes for monitoring well purging, field sample collection, landfill walkover and monitoring well inspection, subcontracted analytical laboratory services, laboratory data review and technical reporting:

2016 Fourth Quarter Baseline Field Sampling & Reporting Services - \$3,500.00
2016 Baseline Subcontracted Laboratory Services - \$1,600.00,
and

WHEREAS: it is essential to continue the monitoring and file the report with the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland approve the expenditure for the monitoring and testing of the Town of Lumberland landfill for 2016 to Barton & Loguidice, in the total amount of \$5,100.00, with monies, to be taken from the LANDFILL ACCOUNT.
