# **TOWN CLERK/TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE**

## **TOWN PAVILION USE**

THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND WILL RESERVE THE TOWN PAVILION TO TOWN RESIDENTS ONLY. ANYONE WISHING TO RESERVE THE PAVILION FOR AN EVENT SHOULD CONTACT THE TOWN CLERK'S OFFICE AT: [deputyclerk@townoflumberland.org](mailto:deputyclerk@townoflumberland.org). THERE IS NOW A FORM THAT WILL NEED TO BE FILLED OUT AND SIGNED BY THE RESIDENT REQUESTING THE USE OF THE PAVILION – THAT FORM CAN BE FAXED OR EMAILED TO YOU AT YOUR REQUEST – ALSO BE AWARE THAT THE TOWN BOARD HAS MANDATED THAT ALL REQUESTS WILL REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE NOTING THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND AS THE ADDITIONAL INSURED AND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 COVERAGE. WE DO NOT RESERVE CIRCLE PARK – IT IS A PUBLIC PARK. THE TOWN PAVILION IS NOT PART OF THE PARK. WE DO NOT RENT THE PARK OR PAVILION. ANYONE USING THE PAVILION IS ASKED TO BRING THEIR OWN GARBAGE CAN LINERS AND DISPOSE OF THEIR GARBAGE WHETHER IT IS IN THE DUMPSTER BEHIND THE SENIOR CENTER OR TAKE IT WITH YOU. IT IS IMPERATIVE YOU DO NOT LEAVE GARBAGE IN THE GARBAGE CANS WHERE ANIMALS CAN GET TO IT. WE ASK THAT EVERYONE KEEP THE AREA AS NEAT AND CLEAN AS YOU FOUND IT – WE REQUEST YOU LEAVE A COUPLE OF TABLES CLOSEST TO THE PARK FREE SO ANYONE THAT NEEDS TO GET OUT OF THE SUN OR NEEDS TO SIT DOWN HAS A PLACE TO DO SO. THERE ARE BASIC RULES POSTED BY THE PAVILION. THERE ARE NOW SECURITY CAMERAS IN PLACE FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY.

## **DOG LICENSING**

THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND REQUIRES ALL DOGS HARBORED IN THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND BE LICENSED. A VALID RABIES CERTIFICATE IS THE REQUIREMENT TO LICENSE YOUR PET. FOR THOSE SENIOR CITIZENS (65+) YOU WILL ONLY HAVE TO PAY \$1 ANNUALLY FOR EACH SPAYED/NEUTERED DOG AND \$3 FOR EACH UNSPAYED/UNNEUTERED DOG. ALL OTHER LICENSES ARE \$3.50 ANNUALLY FOR EACH SPAYED/NEUTERED DOG AND \$13.50 FOR EACH UNSPAYED/UNNEUTERED DOG. IT IS FOR YOUR SAFETY THAT YOU LICENSE YOUR DOG. IF YOUR DOG IS PICKED UP BY OUR DOG CONTROL OFFICER AND TAKEN TO THE SHELTER THE CHARGE IS \$10 FOR THE 1<sup>ST</sup> TIME, \$20 THE SECOND TIME AND \$30 FOR THE 3<sup>RD</sup> TIME WITHIN A 12 MONTH PERIOD. THERE IS ALSO A \$3 A DAY CHARGE ADDED TO THAT IMPOUNDMENT FEE. THE TOWN OF LUMBERLAND HAS A LEASH LAW.




