Local Law No. 1

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR A FOUR YEAR TERM OF OFFICE FOR THE TOWN  
SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provision of Section 24 of the Town Law, the term of office of the Superintendent of Highways in the Town of Lumberland, elected at the election in November 1969, and of all Superintendents of Highways in the Town of Lumberland elected thereafter, shall be four years.

Section 2. This Local Law shall be subject to a mandatory referendum and shall take effect, subject to compliance with the provisions of Section 23, Subdivision 1 of the Municipal Home Rule Law when filed in the office of the Secretary of State, pursuant to Section 27 of such law.
