Town of LUMBERLAND

Local Law No. 1 of the year 1992

A local law to Establish the Appointive Office of Assessor in the Town of Lumberland pursuant to Section 328 of the Real Property Tax Law.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland as follows:

Section I - Purpose

It is the purpose of this law to abolish the three (3) elected offices of Assessor of the Town of Lumberland and to establish the part-time appointive position of Assessor under Section 328 and Section 310 of the RPTL of the State of New York.

Section II - Authority

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Section 328 of the RPTL and Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section III - Date of Transition

The three (3) elected offices of Assessor of the Town of Lumberland shall be abolished as of midnight on January 31, 1993. The Town Board of the Town of Lumberland shall appoint a qualified person to the office of Assessor at its monthly meeting to be held on February 10, 1993.

Section IV - First Term of Office

The first term of office of the appointed Assessor shall be from February 11, 1993 to September 30, 1995, unless otherwise changed pursuant to RPTL Section 310.

Section V - Subsequent Terms of Office

The subsequent terms of office shall be for six (6) consecutive years commencing October 1, 1995, all pursuant to Section 310 of the RPTL of the State of New York.

Section VI - Referendum

The local law shall be subject to a permissive referendum. In the event a petition with sufficient valid signatures and in prescribed form is presented to and certified by the Town Clerk, a Special Election shall be held, on a date to be determined by the Town Board, within sixty (60) days of certification of said petition(s).

Section VII

This local law shall become effective forty-five (45) days after its adoption by the Town Board of the Town of Lumberland.

4. (Subject to permissive referendum and final adoption because no valid petition was filed requesting referendum.)

Such local law was subject to permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum was filed as of January 25, 1993, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.
